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## INVENTORY SCRIPTING VERSION

Freeman Software's Wholesale Inventory program and our Parts & Service Inventory program are now available with a useful "Scripting Feature". What is "Scripting"? It is the ability to use the assembly database while invoicing. Here is what the invoice screen looks like when you start a new invoice. Notice the addition of a new button near the bottom called "Script File". This feature ties into the assembly database and can pop up the assembly screen directly from invoicing. Most businesses that assemble products will find this feature very useful when creating invoices.

Click the scripting button. You now see the assembly screen. Select the assembly you want to use. All items are selected for use. The total price from the last column is displayed on the screen.

You can change the quantity and the unit price on any items selected.

To deselect an item just place the cursor in the “USE” column, highlight the “X” and press the “DEL” key. Move off this cell and the “X” will be gone. It is now removed from the list of selected items.

To select the line again, place the cursor in the “USE” column and press the space bar.

Click “Keep” to keep the selections on this screen or click “Exit and Forget” to discard assembly entries.

Buttons at the bottom: Last, Next, Find, Deselect All, Help, Keep, Exit and Forget.

If you click “Keep” the selections will be pulled back to the invoice screen.

You can now continue with adding more items to the invoice. The selling price adjustments were changed on the assembly screen so you do not need to adjust them on the invoice screen.

When you print the invoice the stock item quantities will be reduced at this time. There were no conversions taking place on the assembly screen.
